

NOTE TO BUYERS: Buyers' selection of animal/s for purchase will be determined by the date of initial down payment deposit. A nonrefundable deposit of \$150.00 per animal is required, unless otherwise agreed upon (e.g. aged animals, large groups, etc.). Deposits will go toward your final cost.*

“Sale Pending” will be noted to listed animals until down payment deposit is received. Deposits must be received within 7 business days to hold the animal or it/they will be added back to the current sales list or retained by Distracted Acres. The balance due must be paid before the animal leaves our premises. Either at the time of pickup, or before the animal is shipped via a 3rd party transporter.

All animals must be picked up or shipped within 10 days of weaning or an agreed upon date by the buyer and Distracted Acres at the time of the sale. All deposits are **NONREFUNDABLE**, except in the case of a legitimate reason determined by Distracted Acres to withdraw animal/s due to concern of future welfare, current soundness or death.

If the animal is not picked up or transported within 10 days of the agreed upon date, the buyer forfeits the animal as well as the down payment deposit. The animal will then be added back to the current sales list or retained by Distracted Acres.

All registered stock will come with papers and information on how to transfer the registration to the new owner. All transfer fees are the responsibility of the buyer.

We offer the utmost attentive care to ensure a profitable healthy future for the animal/s while they reside at our farm. All animals are sold "AS IS". All sales are final. Because we cannot control stress that may occur as a result from shipping, the animal's environment, or management once they leave our farm, we are not responsible for any shipping stress, illness, death or their development. We cannot offer guarantees.

*We go through great lengths to assist buyers out of state with shipping requirements, veterinary inspections, CVI (transportation health certificates), blood tests, DNA tests etc. Regardless, the understanding and review of such information is the responsibility of the buyer, as each state has its own requirements for bringing out of state sheep across the border. We give buyers the right to have any animal you purchase examined by a veterinarian of your choosing at your expense prior to pick up. The buyer will coordinate the date/time of exam with the veterinarian and Distracted Acres.
